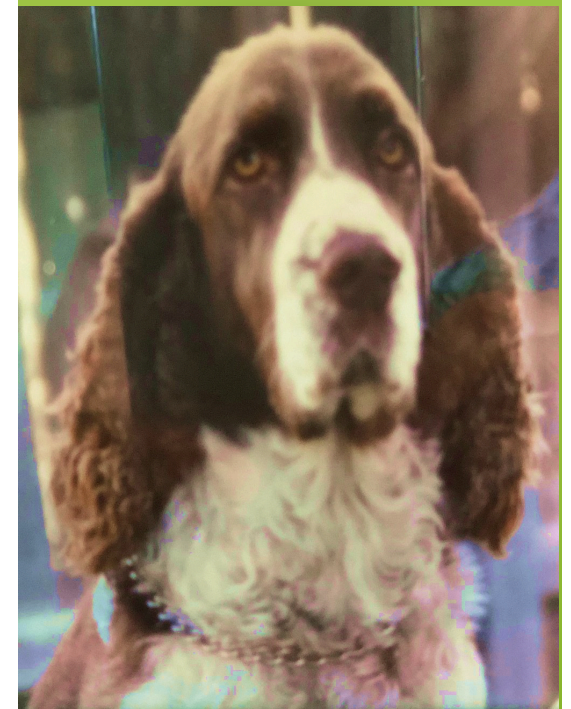
ACCEPTING CASH DONATIONS
